

ARMENIAN-LATVIAN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COMMISSION ON ECONOMIC, INDUSTRIAL, SCIENTIFIC, AND TECHNICAL COOPERATION

The Armenian-Latvian intergovernmental commission on economic, industrial, scientific, and technical cooperation was established in accordance with the Agreement “On economic, industrial, scientific, and technical cooperation between the Republic of Armenia and the Republic of Latvia” signed on December 10, 2009.

The Chair of the Armenian party to the Commission is the RA Deputy Minister of Economy. The 1st session of the Armenian-Latvian joint intergovernmental commission took place in Riga on June 28, 2013. The next, 2nd session of the Commission is envisaged to take place in Yerevan.
